

MARCHING BAND

A marching band unit is a coordinated group of instrumental musicians—often including brass, woodwinds, percussion, and sometimes a color guard—who perform music as they march.

They typically wear matching uniforms, follow a set marching style, and keep in step with the drumline. Marching bands add energy, rhythm, and excitement to a parade, often playing upbeat songs, school fight songs, or patriotic music. *(Band units are organized high school or college bands. If you have a band unit not affiliated with a high school or college, please apply in the Specialty category.)*
